For nearly six decades, the organization has built bridges through its diverse cultural, social, and educational programs. The Annual Turkish Festival, now in its 22nd year, continues to be a cornerstone of these efforts, bringing the heart of Türkiye to the heart of the nation's capital. This year's festival will be held from 11 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Pennsylvania Ave. NW between 3rd and 6th Streets.

Festival Highlights Include:

- **Turkish Cuisine:** Savor authentic dishes from local Washington, D.C. Turkish restaurants, including kebabs, döner, traditional specialties, baklava, and other delightful desserts.
- **Turkish Tea, Coffee & Fortune Reading:** Visit the "Turkish Tea House" for exhibitions and demonstrations of Turkish arts, including paper marbling, and enjoy a cup of Turkish coffee at the "Turkish Coffee House," where fortune-tellers will be on hand to read your coffee grounds.
- **Cultural Exhibitions:** Local artists will showcase handmade ceramics and perform demonstrations of traditional Turkish arts and culture.
- **Grand Bazaar:** Explore the Turkish Bazaar, featuring over 40 vendors offering jewelry, hand-woven textiles, and other Turkish crafts.

- **Arts & Crafts for Kids:** The Kids' Tent will offer hands-on activities that allow children and their parents to engage with Turkish culture and create lasting memories.
- **Stage Performances:** Enjoy diverse live performances that highlight Türkiye's role as a cultural bridge. Performers include Kardelen Turkish Dance Ensemble, Nomad Dancers, the Rhythm and Dance Art Center from Ankara, along with talented local musicians and bands, showcasing traditional Turkish music and modern fusion sounds.
